Policy Aims

We endeavour to:

- Comply with all relevant regulatory requirements
- Continually improve and monitor environmental performance
- Continually improve and reduce environmental impacts
- Incorporate environmental factors into business decisions
- Increase employee awareness and training

Paper

We will:

- Minimise the use of paper in the office
- Reduce packaging as much as possible
- Seek to buy recycled and recyclable paper products
- Reuse and recycle all paper where possible and in compliance with GDPR

Energy and Water

We will seek to:

- Reduce the amount of energy used as much as possible
- Lights and electrical equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Heating will be adjusted with energy consumption in mind
- The energy consumption and efficiency of new products will be taken into account when purchasing.

Plastic

- We will reduce the amount of plastic used
- We will look to replace the use of plastic where possible
- We will aim to recycle all plastics where possible.

General

- We will avoid waste where possible
- Recycle all waste items where possible e.g. toner cartridges and water filters
